<u>Fire Marshal's Report:</u> Jamie <u>Lagassie</u> reported he inspected multiple properties. He needs to do the grange, Riverton Fire <u>House</u> and the churches.

<u>Daytime Driver's Report:</u> The report was emailed prior to the meeting.

LCD: LCD did not meet.

Committee Reports:

<u>Capital</u>: The capital committee will meet after the first of the year.

<u>Firefighter Award</u>: Norman Bird reported that he forwarded the updated LOSAP report and Richard Winn said that he will email the report with the points.

Norman Bird mentioned the benefits that firefighters will have, and it was decided that we should do an explanation of benefits at the next district wide meeting. It would clarify the insurance, personal vehicle insurance and the LOSAP program. Amy O'Toole mentioned that VESO has been cancelled.

<u>Health and Safety</u>: (John Andryzeck and Marie Gillen) – Jim Shanley mentioned that some of his members were concerned with the lack of evening hours, that the spirometry test required proof of COVID vaccine or a negative test within the last three days, and they have some questions / concerns about what would take one person off-duty versus maintain active-duty. It was suggested that they should have a meeting with Jeanine, three chiefs and the health and safety committee. The lack of evening hours is due to the hospital not allowing over time.

Policy: Needs to meet.

<u>Personnel & Update on Hiring Process:</u> The district has received 2 applications so far, but it is still open for another 10 days. The cost of the written test is between \$750 to \$1,000. The committee will meet to go through the applications after the closing date.

Unfinished Business:

- **1. Update on Grants:** Norman Bird reported that Dave Parr is retiring. We are applying for the radio grant which is due December 17th.
- **2. Discussion and Possible Action on Insurance Coverage:** If driving personal vehicle to scene your own insurance is responsible if there is an accident with District Insurance just reimbursing your deductible.

New Business: There was a motion to add ARPA, Juniors, and COVID to the agenda. The motion was made by John Andryzeck and seconded by Dick Ransom. Motion carried.

- **1. COVID:** Barkhamsted is currently in the red zone, there has been 3 fatalities and current recommendations for an enclosed space is to be masked regardless of your vaccination status. The district will leave it up to the individual departments to set their own policies and recommends all follow the CDC and state guidelines.
- **2.** American Rescue Plan Act: Norman Bird reported that Fire Departments are receiving money through this program. He would like to submit ideas into this process which include 4 Jump Kits for Riverton, obtain an AED for the station. Amy O'Toole clarified that the money has

to be used for preventative COVID measures, but regular medical equipment does not qualify. Norman Bird will send the wish list to Richard Winn before next week, which includes an ice sled, a fiber drop into the town garage, raising antennas at BE, and pagers.

3. Juniors: Norman Bird reported that he had a junior recently apply for membership using the regular application form for the Fire Department. Norman Bird found a form from January 2011 that had the details of the Junior Program and wanted to inquire whether the chiefs were still using it.

Training Officer Program: Richard Winn inquired what are good nights? Barkhamsted and Winsted will pilot the SWAT analysis at the Fire School.

There was a motion to adjourn at 8:42. The motion was made by Ralph Scarpino and seconded by Dick Ransom. Motion carried.
